Answers:

- 1> Malcolm X - Malcolm X died of 21 gunshot wounds to his chest, left shoulder, and arms and legs on February 21, 1965.
- 2> Anwar Sadat - Sadat was assassinated during an annual victory parade by an assassination squad that was led by Lieutenant Khalid Islambouli.
- 3> John F. Kennedy - Lee Harvey Oswald was charged with the crime, but he was shot and killed before a trial could take place.
- 4> Abraham Lincoln - Lincoln was shot in the head and died on April 15, 1865 at the age of 56.
- 5> Martin Luther King Jr - James confessed to the assassination on March 10, 1969 and was sentenced to 99 years in prison.
- 6> John Lennon - Chapman was sentenced to 20 years to life.
- 7> Archduke Ferdinand - On Sunday, 28 June 1914, Franz and his wife were killed in Sarajevo. The assassination led to a chain of events that ultimately triggered World War One.
- 8> Lee Harvey Oswald - Originally convicted of Oswald's murder, Ruby appealed and was granted a new trial. However, he became ill and died of lung cancer before the new trial could take place.
- 9> Mahatma Gandhi - Nathuram Godse shot Gandhi in the chest three times on 30 January 1948 in New Delhi.
- 10> Grigori Rasputin - The assassination of Rasputin has become something of a legend and much of the supposed facts may have been simply invented.
- 11> Indira Gandhi - Assassinated in 1984, Indira was the Prime Minister of India.
- 12> Leon Trotsky - Leon was the founder and first leader of the Soviet Red Army.
- 13> Andrew Jackson - The jury found Lawrence 'not guilty by reason of insanity' for the attempted assassination.
- 14> Tsar Nicholas II - Yakov was the chief executioner of Nicholas II and his family.
- 15> Robert F Kennedy - As of 2013, Sirhan is serving a life sentence at Pleasant Valley State Prison in California.
