- 5> Moscow - The number of people killed is disputed. Russian authorities claim only 61 people were killed.

- 8> Midfielder - David Beckham was from Great Britain.
- 9> Dasarath Stadium - This stadium can hold 25, 000 fans.
- 10> Salt Lake Stadium - Salt Lake Stadium can hold 120, 000 fans.
- 11> Spain - This enormous stadium can hold over 99, 000 people.
- 12> 1 - There is one center ref and two assistant referees.
- 13> Zurich - The official FIFA building was completed in 2006.
- 14> Mexico - Brazil won the silver medal.
- 15> Fire - A fire was started by a cigarette. Hundreds were injured and fifty-six people died during the incident.
